



Ring Sizer

1. Print this page and measure the guide above to be sure it is 3.5 inches long between the guidelines. If it is not exactly 3.5 inches, check your printer options to make sure you are printing at 100% and that any "Fit to Page" check boxes are not checked.
2. Cut out the sizer.
3. Wrap the sizer around your finger (note: ensure that the ring will slide comfortably over the knuckle onto the finger).
4. The size lines on the narrow part of the sizer will overlap the red line, which is where you read the size.

Necklace Sizer

1. Print this page. Check your printer options for printing at 100%. Do not print with the option "Fit to Page".
2. Cut out the sizer.
3. Overlap the areas that are marked "A" and tape them together. Make sure the shaded area is underneath and line up the edges.
4. Repeat the above step for areas that are marked "B".
5. Now you can use this as a reference for the length of bracelets and necklaces. This sizer is measured in inches.
